The Career Development Service is delivered at SA Career Consultants Adelaide (CBD)



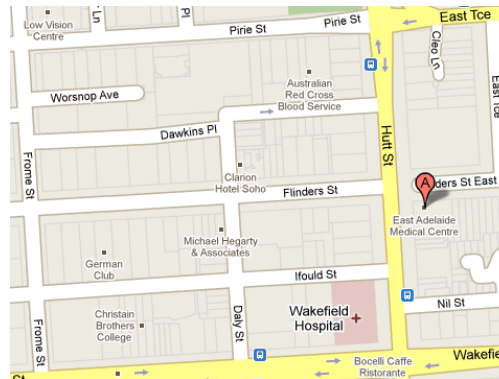

- At least 17 years old
- Not participating in full-time study at any Secondary School, College, TAFE SA or University
