Darryl commenced a 2-week unpaid trial in November 2006 doing routine builds of electronic componentry with in-house servicing and repairs. At the end of the trial, and with some information and support from SACC, Darryl was offered, and accepted a productivity based paid position with DVL.

Michael and the DVL team report that they have seen Darryl’s self esteem and confidence grow and he is viewed as a valued and respected member of the DVL team. It’s a big change for Darryl and he is enjoying using his skills and working in a job he loves.
