Grant – Leading Storeman at Elite Plumbing was happy to train someone to do the work but they were unable to find a person that would take pride in the role and not lose enthusiasm. Stuart completed a 2-week unpaid trial in February 2008 with a SACC job support officer to help him learn the job of tidying up the store room, putting away plumbing components and taking deliveries. At the end of the trial, and with some information and support from SACC, Stuart was offered, and accepted productivity based part time paid position of 5 hours per day, 3 days per week.

Brad reports that Stuart really **IS** the best person for the job and that Stuart's work ethic is second to none. Brad also confirmed that contacting SACC was ideal as they now have a worker who wants to be there, enjoys his work and is doing it well.
